KBMF is working with "Young Hearts 4 Life" to find ways to up the participation at the schools with free ECG screenings. Right now on average only 60% of students sign up for the free screening.

We decided to create a contest for the students to build awareness and raise the participation level at the schools. The students were asked to create a video containing the main facts regarding sudden death and to show the importance of the screening. There will be an award given to the producers of the winning video.

Facts at a Glance:

~More than 7,000 young people under 18 years of age die from undetected heart conditions each year.

~Young athletes suffer sudden cardiac death at a rate 2 to 3 times as high as their less active peers.

 \sim HCM is the most common cause of sudden cardiac death in young adults comprising more than 1/3 of cases.

~HCM is a genetic abnormality present in approximately 1 in 500 people.

~Approximately 60% of young adults at risk for sudden death may be detected with an ECG.
